IP Magic Apply application fluid allows for optimum working conditions on all surfaces, especially those which tend to be more difficult to work with, such as glass, mirrors and flexible substrates (such as PVC banners). Unlike many application solutions, IP Magic Apply does not contain any oil-based ingredients and it better protects, therefore, the integrity of the applied product and of its adhesive system. Consequently, the use of IP Magic Apply, as a bespoke product, will allow for more satisfying results, especially when compared to the use of home-made application solutions that will invariably contain oil. Usage Guidelines: Thoroughly clean the surface using ImagePerfect[™] Surface Cleaner. Do not use alcohol. Spray IP Magic Apply onto the surface in a thin layer, then apply the vinyl with application tape in the usual manner. Remove all excess fluid using a squeegee on the vinyl. After application, dry all areas using a clean cloth. Do not apply at temperatures below +10°C without the necessary thermal post-processing. Attention: We do not recommend the use of this product when working on corrugated or riveted surfaces. Working with heat expands the volume of the liquid and this can cause irreparable air bubbles.
